End-of-Harvest Safety Reminder

As the season wraps up, it's easy to rush through the last tasks, but safety should never take a back seat. Here are a few key reminders:

- Don't stack round bales under or near power lines. Electricity can arc without direct contact, creating a serious fire and electrocution hazard.
- Watch for overhead lines when moving equipment. Grain carts, augers, and combines are often at their tallest during cleanup and transport.
- Plan storage carefully. Temporary bale or grain pile locations should be well clear of power lines and electrical equipment.
- Stay alert during cleanup. Fatigue and shorter daylight hours increase the risk of accidents. Take breaks and use proper lighting.

A little extra care now helps ensure everyone gets home safe and ready for next season.

Updated Electric Service Contract Coming

Our ever-changing industry has revealed gaps in our current Electric Service Contract (ESC) which need to be rectified. Additionally, our Board of Directors have reviewed the liability issues of membership ESC's that have not been signed and determined they cannot allow the outstanding risk for the membership as a whole.

The ESC has been revised over the last year, and we have begun sending out new contracts with the intent to have every member sign an up-to-date ESC. Those who sign and return the new ESC to WWREA by Wednesday, December 31, 2025 will be entered for an opportunity to win a \$500.00 credit towards your monthly electricity bill. The winner will be drawn and announced at the 2026 Annual General Meeting.
